


What is AAC?

Augmentative and Alternative Communication

AAC, also called Augmentative and Alternative Communication, is an area of clinical practice that aims to promote a mode of communication that can suit the needs of every individual.

AAC is a flexible communicative system that helps people with communication disorders by supplementing written language with visual supports. AAC can therefore be used to enable people with speech impairments to communicate and relate to other people in an efficient way.

AAC allows individuals to build a mode of communication that helps them to interact, thereby overcoming, and in fact breaking, any kind of language barrier.



































